



Archepiscopal Encyclical for the Exaltation of the Holy Cross The Feast of the Universal Exaltation of the Precious and Life-giving Cross

September 14, 2024

To the Most Reverend and Right Reverend Hierarchs, Pious Priests and Deacons, Monks and Nuns, Presidents and Members of the Parish Councils, Honorable Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, Members of Leadership 100, Day and Afternoon Schools, Philoptochos Societies, Youth, Greek Orthodox Organizations, and entirety of the Christloving Plenitude of the Sacred Archdiocese of America:

The Cross is exalted today, and the cosmos is sanctified... (Exapostilarion)

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

Today, we celebrate the Discovery of the True Cross upon which our Lord Jesus Christ was crucified. For centuries, it had lain hidden beneath the rubble and devastation that the Roman armies had inflicted upon Jerusalem and Her surroundings. Until the mission to the Holy Land of Saint Helen, mother to the holy Emperor Constantine, who ended persecution against Christians and called the First Ecumenical Council.

The finding of this sacred relic is the cause for our Feast today, the Universal Exaltation of the Holy and Life-giving Cross. Throughout the Sacred Archdiocese of America and around the world, the Cross of the Lord will be lifted up with fragrant basil, and faithful Orthodox Christians will fall down before it, just as they did at its first Elevation, when Saint Makarios, Archbishop of Jerusalem, raised on high the Cross that granted the miracle of resurrection. But as in the days of Saint Helen, before the Cross can be exalted, it must first be discovered.

So, where is the Cross to be found today? Is it only present in the precious fragments that are ensconced in reliquaries around the globe? In truth, the discovery of the Cross is available to every Christian who seeks to follow the example of our Lord's self-sacrificial love. The Cross is buried in our hearts through Baptism, and lies deep within us, waiting to be revealed by our thoughts and intentions, by our words, and by



our actions. Its discovery transforms a human being into a self-aware child of God, who then raises up the Cross in their own lives and shares in the divine plan of sanctifying the cosmos.

This is the daily work and calling of the devout men and women studying at our beloved Hellenic College & Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology, and today is their special Feastday. Let us all make every effort to support them and all those who labor at our precious Theological School, so that the Holy and Lifegiving Cross may manifest more and more in our own lives, and throughout the world.

Κατά τή σημερινή ήμέρα, έορτάζουμε την εύρεση του Σταυρού έπάνω στον όποιο σταυρώθηκε ό Κύριός μας Ίησους Χριστός. Σὲ ὁλόκληφη τὴν Ἀρχιεπισκοπή Αμεφικῆς, ἀλλὰ καὶ σὲ ὅλο τὸν κόσμο, ὁ Σταυφὸς τοῦ Κυφίου θὰ ὑψωθεῖ, στολισμένος μὲ εὕοσμο βασιλικό, ἐνῷ οὶ πιστοὶ ὀφθόδοξοι χριστιανοὶ θὰ προσκηνύσουν μὲ εὐλάβεια, μιμούμενοι τοὺς χριστιανοὺς στὴν πρώτη ΰψωση, ὅταν ὁ ἄγιος Μακάριος, Αρχιεπίσκοπος Τεροσολύμων, ὕψωσε ψηλὰ ἐκεῖνο τὸ Σταυφό, ὡς σημεῖο τοῦ θαύματος τῆς ἀναστάσεως. Όμως, ὅπως ἐπὶ τῶν ἡμερῶν τῆς ἀγίας Ἑλένης, ἡ ὕψωση τοῦ τιμίου σταυφοῦ προϋποθέτει τὴν εὕφεσή του.

We kindly remind the ladies to please remove their lipstick before they approach the Holy Communion.



The Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America Announces the Launch of the Greek Fire Relief Fund

Under the leadership of His E0minence Archbishop Elpidophoros of America, the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America announces the launch of the Greek Fire Relief Fund to aid the communities in the Attica region affected by the devastating fires that took place earlier this month. The Greek Orthodox Ladies Philoptochos Society will be partnering in this effort as well and has approved a contribution of \$50,000 towards this effort.

To commence, a delegation consisting of His Grace Bishop Athenagoras of Nazianzos, Chief Secretary of the Holy Eparchial Synod; Elaine Allen, Treasurer of the Archdiocese; and Philoptochos First Vice President Anita Kartalopoulos will visit affected areas from Monday, August 26-Thursday, August 29, 2024. Allen and Kartalopoulos were also members of a delegation which visited Evia, an island severely impacted by 2021 wildfires, inspected the devastation, met with impacted individuals, and assessed unmet needs.

In response to the 2021 Evia fires, the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America in conjunction with the Greek Orthodox Ladies Philoptochos Society launched a nationwide fundraising campaign that provided immediate and extended support to the fire-affected population on Evia.

The present delegation will meet with His Beatitude the Archbishop of Athens Ieronymos to understand the impact on the region under his jurisdiction, perform a needs assessment, identify gaps in funding, and develop an assistance plan. They will also view firsthand the Monastery of Panagia Axion Esti, which was engulfed by fire; this monastery is a place of historic importance to the Archdiocese of Athens, housing valuable ecclesiastical relics. Following the precedent set by previous wildfire response efforts, the Archdiocese will minimize administrative costs in order that funds raised will directly benefit the region affected by the fires.

In announcing the Fund, Archbishop Elpidophoros stated, "We once again call upon our faithful, our parishes, and our institutions, to help ease to suffering of our brothers and sisters in Greece. As we wait for a full assessment of the needs in Greece, our Archdiocese will fund the restoration of the Monastery of Panagia Axion Esti in Varnava Attica ensuring that this historic and beloved Monastery of the Archdiocese of Athens will continue to serve the community for many years."

During their time in Greece, the delegation will also visit northern Evia to visit the health centers in Mantoudi and Istiaia, where the 2021 fundraising campaign purchased medical equipment and two ambulances. The delegation will also view the Agios Nicolaos Galataki Monastery water restoration project financed by the previous campaign. The 2021 fundraising campaign raised more than \$1.1 million, which has been distributed to affected individuals, businesses, healthcare providers, and the Agios Nicolaos Galataki Monastery.


