



Archepiscopal Encyclical on the Fourth of July

July 4, 2025

Unto the Most Reverend and Right Reverend Hierarchs, Pious Priests and Deacons, the Monks and Nuns, Presidents and Members of Parish Councils, Honorable Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, Members of Leadership 100, the Day and Afternoon Schools, Philoptochos Societies, the Youth, Greek Orthodox Organizations, and the entirety of the Christ-named Plenitude of the Sacred Archdiocese of America:

Ἐάν ὑμεῖς μείνητε ἐν τῷ λόγῳ τῷ ἐμῷ, ἀληθῶς μαθηταὶ μού ἔστε, καὶ γνῶσεσθε τὴν ἀλήθειαν, καὶ ἡ ἀλήθεια ἐλευθερώσει ὑμᾶς. (κατὰ Ἰωάννην 8:31-32)

If you abide in My Message, then you are truly My followers, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. (John 8:31-32)

My beloved brothers and sisters in the Lord,


The Fourth of July is much more than the American celebration of liberty. It is the memory of that moment of the turning of the tide, when a people who were abused by the powerful chose to stand up for themselves and grasp for the freedom that their conscience told them was their "unalienable right." And this is the very same liberty that we constantly strive to preserve and ensure in this blessed American land for the liberties of all people, regardless of their race, ethnicity, religion, or national origin. However, a true freedom that is equal for every human being can only come from God, in the inner person.

The Lord Jesus Christ told His disciples that the truth would set them free. But in a world where the truth oftentimes appears to be obscured, we find ourselves frequently asking the same question as the man who ordered the crucifixion of our Lord did two millennia ago, "What is truth?" If we are able to *know* the truth of things, then we must also recognize that the condition for that knowledge is abiding in the Logos — the Message of the One Who ascended the Cross of His own free will for our salvation.

Therefore, freedom and truth are inextricably linked in the person of our Savior. If we are not truthful people — or in other words, if we are not *of* the truth, as the Lord answered Pontius Pilate (John 18:37) — then our perception will always be shackled to our own personal opinions or our willingness to blindly follow the views of others and not the Logos of the Word of God. And this, my dear friends, is contrary to the ethos and authentic perspective of the Orthodox Church and the Gospel.

On our Nation's Birthday, then, when the entire world and our Country yearn for truth and peace — the firm and unyielding hallmarks of a genuine life in Christ — let us commit to truly being Christ's followers. The Lord understands our need for freedom and knowledge, but He bestows them upon us in proportion to the measure of our faithfulness and the good deeds that we perform as His servants. Let us, therefore, strive to be honest disciples of His Divine Word, so that we may "know the truth" (John 8:32) and be truly free!

«Ἐὰν ὑμεῖς μείνητε ἐν τῷ λόγῳ τῷ ἐμῷ, ἀληθῶς μαθηταὶ μού ἔστε καὶ γνῶντεσθε τὴν ἀλήθειαν καὶ ή ἀλήθεια ἐλευθεράστε ὑμᾶς» (Κατὰ Ιαλάνην 8, 31-32).

Προσφιλεῖς ἀδελφοὶ καὶ ἀδελφὲς ἐν Χριστῷ,

Ἡ Τετάρτη Ιουλίου εἶναι κάτι περιουσότερο ἀπὸ μία ἐօρτη τῆς ἐλευθερίας στὴν Αμερική. Εἶναι ή ἵστορική μνήμη ἐκείνης τῆς ιστιγμῆς, διαν ἔνας καταπιεσμένος λαός ἀποφάνεται νὰ ξειπηκαθεῖ καὶ νὰ διεκδικήσει τὴν ἐλευθερία του, ὅπως ἡ συνειδητή του καταδεικνύει, ὡς «ἀναφαίρετο δικαίωμα». Καὶ αὐτῇ ἡ ἐλευθερία εἶναι κάτι ποὺ προσπαθοῦμε νὰ κρατήσουμε ζωντανό καὶ ἐμπρακτό σὲ αὐτῇ τὴν εὐλογημένη χώρα, γιὰ δλοὺς τὸν ἀνθρώπους, ἀνεξαρτήτως φυλῆς, ἐθνικότητας, θρησκείας, ἢ

καταγωγής. Όμως η ἀληθινή ἐλευθερία, ποὺ εἶναι ἀπόσωπόλιγπη, μπορεῖ νὰ προέλθει μονάχα ἀπὸ τὸ Θεό καὶ νὰ φιέσει μέσα στὸ βάθος τῆς καρδιᾶς μας.

Ο Κύριος μας Ἰησοῦς Χριστὸς εἶπε στοὺς μαθητές του ὅτι η ἀληθεία θὰ τοὺς ἐλευθερώσει. Άλλα σὲ ἔναν κόσμο ὅπου η ἀληθεία συχνά μοιάζει θολή, ἔρχεται στὸ νοῦ μας η ἐρώτηση τοῦ ἀνθρώπου ποὺ παρέδωσε τὸ Χριστὸ στὸ σταυρικό θάνατο: «Τί ἐστιν ἀληθεία;» Μποροῦμε νὰ γνωρίσουμε τὴν ἀληθεία, μόνο ἀν παραμείνουμε ἐνωμένοι μὲ τὸ Λόγο, αὐτὸν ποὺ ἀνέβηκε στὸ σταυρὸ μὲ ίδια θέληση, γιὰ νὰ μᾶς σώσει.

Ἐπομένως, ἐλευθερία καὶ ἀληθεία εἶναι δεμένες μεταξύ τους στὸ πρόσωπο τοῦ Χριστοῦ. Εάν δὲν εἴμαστε ἀληθινοὶ ἀνθρώποι, δηλαδὴ ἔαν δὲν ἀνήκουμε στὴν ἀληθεία, ὅπως εἶπε ὁ Κύριος στὸν Πιλάτο (Ιω. 18, 37), τότε δὲν βλέπουμε καὶ ἀντιλαμβανόμαστε θὰ παραμένει δεμένο μὲ τὴν ὑποκειμενική μας γνῶμη η μὲ τὴν ἀκριτή ἀποδοχή ὥσων λένε οἱ ἄλλοι, καὶ δχι μὲ τὸ Λόγο τοῦ Θεοῦ. Αὐτὸ δὲν ταιριάλει στὸ φρόνημα καὶ τῇ ζωῇ ποὺ προτείνει ἡ Ορθόδοξη Ἑκκλησία καὶ τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο τοῦ Χριστοῦ.

Ἐνῷ τὸ Ἀμερικανικὸ Έθνος μας γιορτάζει σῆμερα τὴν ἡμέρα τῆς γεννήσεώς του, τῇ στιγμῇ ποὺ ὁ κόσμος ἀναζητεῖ ἀπεγνωσμένα τὴν ἀληθεία καὶ τὴν εἰρήνη, τὰ όποια ἀποτελοῦν ιαὶ τὰ σταθερὰ σημεῖα μας ζωῆς μέσα στὸ φῶς τοῦ Χριστοῦ, ἀς ἀποφασίσουμε νὰ γίνουμε ἀληθινοὶ μαθητές του. Ο Κύριος γνωρίζει τὴ δίψα μας γιὰ ἐλευθερία καὶ γνῶση, ἀλλὰ τὰ δώρα αὐτὰ τὰ προσφέρει ἀνάλογα μὲ τὴν πίστη μας καὶ τὰ καλὰ ἔργα ποὺ κάνουμε ως ὑπηρέτες του. Ας προσπαθήσουμε, λοιπόν, νὰ εἴμαστε τίμοι καὶ πιστοί μαθητές τοῦ Λόγου, γιὰ νὰ μπορέσουμε νὰ γνωρίσουμε τὴν ἀληθεία καὶ νὰ ζησουμε ὄντως ἐλεύθεροι!






