BRETHREN, when God made a promise to Abraham, since he had no one greater by whom to swear, he swore to himself, saying, "Surely I will bless you and multiply you." And thus Abraham, having patiently endured, obtained the promise. Men indeed swear by a greater than themselves, and in all their disputes an oath is final for confirmation. So when God desired to show more convincingly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeable character of his purpose, he interposed with an oath, so that through two unchangeable things, in which it is impossible that God should prove false, we who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to seize the hope set before us. We have this as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope that enters into the inner shrine behind the curtain, where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf, having become a high priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.



At that time, a man came to Jesus kneeling and saying: "Teacher, I brought my son to you, for he has a dumb spirit; and wherever it seizes him it dashes him down; and he foams and grinds his teeth and becomes rigid; and

> I asked your disciples to cast it out, and they were not able." And he answered them, "O faithless generation, how long am I to be with you? How long am I to bear with you? Bring him to me." And they brought the boy to him; and when the spirit saw him, immediately it convulsed the boy, and he fell on the ground and rolled about, foaming at the mouth. And Jesus asked his father, "How long has he had this?" And he said, "From childhood. And it has often cast him into the

fire and into the water, to destroy him; but if you can do anything, have pity on us and help us." And Jesus said to him, "If you can! All things are possible to him who believes." Immediately the father of the child cried out and said, "I believe; help my unbelief!" And when Jesus saw that a crowd came running together, he rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it, "You dumb and deaf spirit, I command you, come out of him, and never enter him again." And after crying out and convulsing him terribly, it came out, and the boy was like a corpse; so that most of them said, "He is dead." But Jesus took him by the hand and lifted him up, and he arose. And when he had entered the house, his disciples asked him privately, "Why could we not cast it out?" And he said to them, "This kind cannot be driven out by anything but prayer and fasting." They went on from there and passed through Galilee. And he would not have any one know it; for he was teaching his disciples, saying to them, "The Son of man will be delivered into the hands of men, and they will kill him; and when he is killed, after three days he will rise."

Archiepiscopal Encyclical on the Feast of the Annunciation of the Theotokos and the Celebration of Greek Independence Day

March 25, 2023

Unto the Most Reverend and Right Reverend Hierarchs, Pious Priests and Deacons, the Monks and Nuns, Presidents and Members of Parish Councils, Honorable Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarchate, Members of Leadership 100, the Day and Afternoon Schools, Philoptochos Societies, the Youth, Greek Orthodox Organizations, and the entirety of the Christ-named Plenitude of the Holy Archdiocese of America:

Hail, unnoavering tower of the Church, hail impenetrable wall of the Kingdom!

Beloved Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

This Day of Greek Independence – when throughout Greece, Cyprus and the Hellenic Diaspora, the people of God celebrate freedom and remember the cost thereof – let us train our minds on the Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary, who is the model for what that freedom truly means. We sing her praises throughout Great Lent in the magnificent Akathist Hymn, because March 25 is the date we observe her Annunciation of the Glad Tidings of the Lord's Incarnation, and because the Rebirth of the *Genos* is bound to her mighty intercessions.

The Theotokos is truly our "unwavering tower" and "impenetrable wall;" for she stands fast at the Throne of God in constant supplication for her People, the People of the Church, and the citizens of the coming Kingdom. She is the guarantor of our Faith; for she is the one who offered her humanity to God, so that God, in turn, could offer His Divinity to us. She manifests that each of us has a place in the work of salvation, for through her, we are consubstantial with the Son of God in His humanity, just as He is consubstantial with the Father and the Spirit in divinity.



The fact that the struggle for freedom is forever linked to the exercise of her own freedom, is a cause for celebration every day, and not only on March 25. We can hold in our minds and hearts the champions of 1821 in every *kairos*, for their example is ever-new and ever-young. Their sacrifices remind us of the costly price of liberty, so that we might never take for granted the freedoms won and what it takes to preserve them.

Therefore, my beloved brethren in the Lord, let us chant and magnify the Theotokos with joyous hymns and heartfelt supplications that may ever be worthy of the "unwavering tower" and "impenetrable wall" that surrounds us with love and spiritual protection. And may we ever bring to the exercise of our democracies of Greece, Cyprus, America, and everywhere in the Diaspora where "government of the people, by the people, for the people" is honored, the determination and responsibility to make us worthy of the freedoms that were gifted to us by the Heroes of 1821.

Long live Greece!

Κατά τή σημεφινή έπέτειο τῆς έλληνικῆς ἐπαναστάσεως καὶ τῆς ἐθνικῆς ἀνεξαφτησίας, ὅλοι οἱ ἐλληνες στῆν Ἑλλάδα, στήν Κύπφο καὶ στή διασποφὰ ἑοφτάζουμε τῆν ἑλευθεφία καὶ ἀναλογιζόμαστε τἰς θυσίες ποὺ ἔγιναν γιὰ αὐτῆ, ἔχοντας ὡς ὑπόδειγμα ἀληθινῆς ἐλευθεφίας τὴν Παναγία Θεοτόκο καὶ ἀειπάφθενο Μαφία. Ψάλλουμε τὸν Ακάθιστο Ύμνο κατὰ τὴ διάφκεια τῆς Μεγάλης Τεσσαφακοστῆς, τιμώντας την, γιατὶ τὴν 25ⁿ Μαφτίου δέχεται τὸ χαφμόσυνο ἄγγελμα, τὸν εὐαγγελισμὸ ἀπὸ τὸν ἀφχάγγελο γιὰ τὴν ἐνανθρώπιση τοῦ Κυφίου, καὶ τὴν ῖδια ἡμέφα πολλά χρόνια μετὰ, ἡ ίδια Παναγία ἀναγεννάει τὸ γένος μας μὲ τὴν παντοδύναμη μεσιτεία της.

Η Θεοτόκος είναι στήν κυφιολεξία «ό άσάλευτος πύφγος» καὶ «τὸ ἀπόφθητο τείχος»! Ἀπαφασάλευτη μεσίτοια στο θρόνο τοῦ Θεοῦ, μεσιτεύοντας συνεχῶς γιὰ τὸ λαό τῆς, τὸ λαὸ τῆς Ἐκκλησίας, τοὺς πολῖτες τῆς βασιλείας τῶν οὐφανῶν, Είναι ή ἐγγυήτοια



τῆς πίστης μας, διότι ὁ Θεὸς λαμβάνει ἀπὸ αὐτή τὴν ἀνθρώπινη φύση, γιὰ νὰ καταστήσει τὸν ἄνθρωπο κατὰ χάριν θεὸ, ἀποδεικνύοντας ὅτι καθένας ἀπὸ ἑμᾶς ἑχει τὸ δικό του ρόλο στὸ ἔργο τῆς σωτηρίας. Διὰ τῆς Θεοτόκου γινόμαστε ὅμοιοι μὲ τὸν Υἰὸ τοῦ Θεοῦ κατὰ τὴν ἀνθρωπότητα, ὅπως ὁ Υἰὸς εἶναι ὁμοούσιος μὲ τὸν Πατέρα καὶ τὸ Ἀγιο Πνεῦμα κατὰ τὴ θεότητα.

Αύτή ή έλευθερία πού έξασκει ή Θεοτόκος σχετίζεται μὲ τοὺς ἀγῶνες γιὰ τὴν έλευθερία τοῦ γένους μας καὶ είναι ἀφορμὴ γιὰ ἑορτασμοὺς καθημερινὰ καὶ ὅχι μόνο κατὰ τὴν ἡμέρα τῆς 25^{sc} Μαρτίου. Ἀς κρατήσουμε τὴ μνήμη τῶν ἀγωνιστῶν τοῦ εἰκοσιένα ζωντανὴ μέσα στὴν καρδιὰ μας κάθε στιγμή, γιατὶ τὸ παράδειγμὰ τους εἶναι πἀντοτε επίκαιρο. Οἱ ἀγῶνες τους μᾶς ὑπενθυμίζουν ὅτι τὸ κόστος γιὰ τὴν ἐλευθερία εἶναι βαρὒ καὶ χρειάζονται θυσίες τόσο γιὰ τὴν κατάκτηση ὅσο καὶ γιὰ τὴ διατήρηση της.

Άς ψάλουμε λοιπόν, άγαπητοί μου άδελφοί, εύχαφιστηφίους ύμνους και ώδὲς πνευματικές πφὸς τή Θεοτόκο, παφακαλώντας την νὰ παφαμείνει πάντοτε «ὁ ἀσάλευτος πύφγος» καὶ «τὸ ἀπόφθητον τεῖχος», πφοστατεύοντάς μας μὲ ἀγἀπη καὶ πνευματικὴ πφοστασία, καὶ ὡς διαφυλἀττουμε τἰς δημοκφατίες μας στὴν Ἐλλάδα, στὴν Κύπφο καὶ παντοῦ στὴ διασποφὰ, ὅπου «ἡ ἑξουσία ἀντλεῖται ἀπό τὸ λαό γιὰ τὸ λαό», γιατὶ ἔχουμε τὴ μεγάλη τιμὴ καὶ τὴν εὐθύνη ὡστε νὰ παφαμείνουμε ἀντάξιοι τῆς ἑλευθεφίας ποὺ μᾶς χάφισαν οἱ ἤφωες τοῦ 1821.
